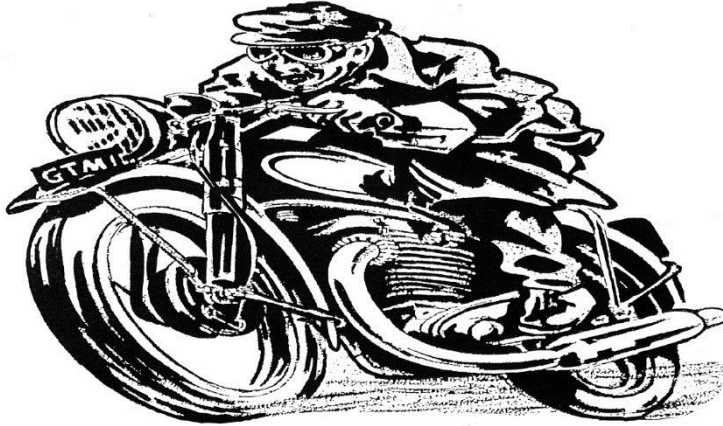

To help with pre-event publicity we are always looking for clubs or individuals with an interesting bike and/or associated story, if you can help with pre-event publicity please let us know. It would be helpful if you could make an A4 sized Club fact sheet for display with the club name, membership contact, when/where you meet, when you started, club events/next event. Also, for each machine a further sheet with make & model, age, engine type, number of gears, how long the owner has had it, have they preserved or restored it. Your stand area measurement **must include any vehicle(s) and/or equipment required to be located at your stand throughout the event.** Any vehicles not required on the stand must be removed to outside the venue by 10am.

The site is open from 9am to 7pm on Saturday 8th September for set-up.

Site security in place from 7pm through until the gates open again for exhibitors at 7am on Sunday.

On-site camping is not permitted.

Please return the completed form to the Events Team at GTM. Your booking will be confirmed on receipt, and all tickets and arrival instructions will be sent out nearer the event. If your space requirement is more than 9m² we will require full payment to confirm your stand. Please make cheques payable to **Grampian Transport Museum**

Anyone arriving on a vehicle which is to be part of a Club stand will need to present their free pass to gain entry. No display vehicles are allowed in after the 10am.

Conditions of Entry

1. 2 free tickets will be supplied against each Club stand booking, plus 1 per bike on the stand.
2. The Grampian Transport Museum Trust, officials and agents shall accept no responsibility nor entertain claims resulting from accident, loss or damage arising out of, or in any way connected with, participation in the Grampian Motorcycle Convention.
3. Stand holders must hold public liability insurance and perform a health and safety risk assessment, which meets and complies with all current H&S legislation.
4. Any ground rent payable at the time of booking confirmation is not refundable.
