PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

The Junior Driving School is a serious attempt to install a sense of road safety awareness into very young children (4 to 10 year olds). It is a good example of 'learning through play', the principle being that youngsters are much more likely to take note of road signs, road markings and basic rules of the road if they are enjoying themselves. The 'School' is designed to be **FUN** but this is not a karting or dodgem experience! The electric cars are very safe and very slow – learning to negotiate the miniature road layout is the principle objective.

The School can only operate in dry conditions and during the published or negotiated opening hours. Please do phone ahead in the event of uncertain weather. In the interests of safety and to prevent damage to the vehicles the operator has a radio cut off device which he will use to stop all the cars if a driver is in difficulty or is deliberately driving dangerously. The operator has the authority to exclude any drivers on safety or damage limitation grounds and we ask for parental support in this. At all times parents/accompanying adults are responsible for their children and the Driving School cannot accommodate unaccompanied youngsters.

A maximum of 16 children can be catered for with a school booking. Each child will receive 2 lessons and a driving test (which will take about 1 ½ hours). The charge for this is £5 per head.
